By acquiring the profession of a doctor and realizing the importance of the duties entrusted to me, in the presence of my teachers and colleagues I solemnly **SWEAR to:**

- devote all knowledge, strength and ability to the protection and improvement of human health, treatment and prevention of diseases, to provide medical care to all who need it;
- be invariably guided in my actions and thoughts by the principles of universal morality, to be selfless and sensitive to the patient, to admit my mistakes, to continue with dignity the noble traditions of world medicine;
- be bound by medical confidentiality so as not to harm the person;
- follow the rules of professional ethics, do not hide the truth, if it does not harm the patient;
- constantly deepen and improve my knowledge and skills, if necessary, seek help from colleagues and by myself never deny them in this, be fair to colleagues;
- promote by my own example, the education of a physically and morally healthy generation, to affirm the high ideals of mercy, love, harmony and mutual respect between people.

I swear to pledge allegiance to this Oath throughout my life.
