



CORPORATE CODE OF ETHICS OF KHARKIV NATIONAL MEDICAL UNIVERSITY

Believing that medical knowledge should serve humane purposes, that intellectual development of the person should be combined with its moral growth; respecting high traditions of the Ukrainian medical science and higher education, adhering to traditions of noble and selfless service to science; understanding that belonging to medical university demands high standards of professionalism and high moral behavior, the university staff accepts and undertakes to adhere to such a Code of Ethics, which defines the basic moral principles established by the university community.

- To take care of the prestige of Kharkiv National Medical University in the field of education, science and innovation, to protect its interests in all spheres of activity.
- Honestly and responsibly treat professional responsibilities, protect the interests of the University, while performing teaching, research and community work.
- To adhere to the moral principle “Do no harm!” patient, neighbor, nature, society and the next generation.
- To respect the rights and dignity of the individual. In relations between students and teachers to adhere to the norms of mutual respect and equal cooperation, tact and correctness, politeness and tolerance.
- To not allow national, religious, racial and gender intolerance.
- To maintain an atmosphere of friendliness, friendship, mutual assistance and mutual responsibility in the study groups and the University as a whole.
- Always take care of the honor and dignity of everyone within the walls of the University, avoid situations that could damage the prestige and image of the Kharkiv National Medical University
- Constantly raise the educational and cultural level, realizing the educational mission of the doctor and his belonging to intellectual elite of Ukraine.
